

PHOTOGRAPHY AND FILMING GUIDELINES

All filming and photography must be approved by the RCJ events team. Filming and photography will not be allowed at the venue without prior permission.

RCJ events will approve the intended use of all film and photography with Her Majesty's Courts Services. RCJ events must have full details of how and where the photos and film footage is intended to be used. Failure to disclose full details of filming/photo shoots may cause RCJ events to cancel shoots without prior notice.

Access to the venue is from 5pm. Press must arrive via the West Green Entrance off the Strand. There will be a member of staff from the RCJ events team available to meet you.

If you require parking this should be arranged in advance of your visit.

Please note that RCJ events will require your vehicle registration details prior to entry or access will not be granted on the day.

No journalist may enter any of the Court Rooms.

Please do not block staircases, doorways, emergency exits, lifts or access to corporate events spaces.

Any electrical equipment brought into the Museum must be PAT tested. RCJ events cannot authorise the use of electrical equipment without a valid PAT test label.

There may be restrictions with regard to certain areas of the RCJ. Please follow guidelines set by RCJ events staff.

Filming or interviewing in Court Rooms will never be permitted at any time.

All photography and filming must take place after 5pm to avoid disruption to the Working Courts.
